6. They had *all things common* (**common access and common privilege**)

- What does it mean to have all things common among the saints?
- How do we begin this process?

7. There were *no rich and poor/no poor among them*. (**equality**)

- What does this tell us about where we are currently in the centerplace?
- Are the principles of financial stewardship part of this discussion?
- Is this just for members of the restoration branches or the community as a whole? If just for members what about the residue of people-the majority around us?
- How can we function more diligently and transformitively in our temporal affairs?
